2. Prevention of the illegal and unreserved activities of the bio-diversified resources which comes under the Bio-diversity Deciding Committee.
3. Giving suggestions to the subjects sent for approval by the State Bio-diversity Board or Authority.
4. The Bio-diversity Deciding Committee is authorized to impose expenses upon any person who intends to collect the bio-diversity resources for commercial purpose, from the areas which comes under the committee's functional area limit.
5. Collecting and maintain statistical information of the doctors and professionals who use the bio-diversity resources.
6. Regarding availing the opportunities of obtaining the bio-diversity resources and traditional knowledge provided by the committee.
7. Maintaining a register to record the information about imposition of collection fees and details of the benefits available and its distribution methods.
8. It will be the responsibility of the committee to get involved in documenting the bio-diversity and bio-diversity related local traditional knowledge.
9. Utilization and maintenance of the bio-diversity grants as per the directions of the National Bio-diversity Authority and Karnataka Bio-diversity Board.
