STATEMENT OF OBJECTIONS BY RESPONDENT NO.6

The Respondent No.6 above named submits as follows:

It is submitted that in this application, the Applicant has sought for various directions against the Respondents herein directing to maintain Amrit Mahal Kavals free from diversion/encroachment, to remove civil constructions illegally erected, and to restore the Amrit Mahal Kavals to its original state and that a direction to Respondents No.1 to 9 to commission the Regional Environment Impact Assessment to study carrying capacity and to comprehend the impact of all projects proposed in this region on bio-diversity, environment, and human settlement etc., before taking any decision for granting approval to any or all projects and further direction to commission a comprehensive study of Socio Economic Impacts of the proposed projects on Agrarian and Pastoral Community of the region and also to conduct a comprehensive study and audit of the land use, water use by each project from the point of view of the location, demand for land and such other consideration before granting environment clearance and consent for establishment for the proposed projects. The Respondent No.6 most respectfully submits that, in so far as this Respondent is concerned, the application filed before this Hon'ble Tribunal is not maintainable either in law or on facts and therefore, the same is liable to be dismissed.

- It is submitted that the Ministry of Environment and Forest, Government of India, in exercise of powers conferred by sub-section (1) and Clause V of sub-section (2) of Section 3 of the Environment (Protection) Act, 1986, read with Clause (d) of sub-rule (3) of Rule 5 of the Environment (Protection) Rules, 1986 issued a notification (hereinafter referred to as "EIA Notification 2006"] wherein, the Central Government directed that on and from the date of the publication of the said notification, the construction of new projects or activities or expansion or modernization of existing projects or activities listed in the schedule to the said notification shall be undertaken in any part of India only after the prior environmental clearance from Central Government or as the case may be by the State Level Environment Impact Assessment Authority duly constituted by the Central Government.
- 3. Paragraph 3 of the said EIA notification 2006 provides for constitution of State Level Environment Impact Assessment Authority i.e. Respondent No.6 herein and pursuant to which, on 01-10-2010, Ministry of Environment and Forest, Government of India, issued a notification constituting the State Level Environment Impact Assessment Authority (SEIAA) for Karnataka State. A copy of the said notification is produced and marked as ANNEXURE-'R2'. Sub-para (3) of Para 3 of EIA Notification 2006 provides the eligibility criteria and qualifications two members which is given in Appendix-VI to the EIA Notification, 2006 and Sub-para (4) thereof, provides that one of the specified members in sub-para (3) who is an expert in the Environment Impact

Assessment process, shall be the Chairman of Karnataka State Environment Impact Assessment Authority. Appendix VI to the EIA Notification 2006, provides for eligibility criteria. Thus experts and professionals who fulfils the eligibility criteria in Appendix VI to the EIA Notification 2006, would be appointed as Chairman and Member of the Karnataka State Environment Impact Assessment Authority i.e. the Respondent No.6 herein.

4. Para 7 of the EIA Notification 2006, provides that the process of granting environmental clearance would comprise four stages and they are:

Stage-1: Screening (only for Category-B projects and activities).

> Stage-2: Scope

> Stage-3: Public consultation.

> Stage-4: Appraisal.

5. The entire scheme of the EIA Notification 2006, and four stages of process provided thereunder for granting environmental clearance, if appreciated, the main function of this Respondent i.e. Karnataka State Environment Impact Assessment Authority would to act as an expert body while granting prior environmental clearance to any project or activities listed in the Schedule to the EIA Notification, 2006 and while considering the said aspect, it has to determine, the terms of reference comprehensively addressing all relevant environmental concerns for the preparation of EIA Report in respect of the projects or activities. The Respondent No.6 authority has no suo motu powers to take any action or to take cognizance of any violations of the provisions of the Environment (Protection) Act, 1986 and/or any notification

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issued thereunder. The Respondent No.6 authority is only an expert body consisting of experts having qualification provided in Appendix VI to the notification. If at all any action is to be taken for the violators of the provisions as aforesaid, it is for the Ministry of Environment and Forest, Government of India, to take such action as has been provided under the Provisions of Environment (Protection) Act, 1986. Therefore, in so far as Respondent No.6 is concerned, the application is liable to be dismissed.

6. All other allegations which are not hereby traversed are denied as not correct.

Wherefore, Respondent No.6 respectfully prays that this Hon'ble Tribunal be pleased to pass such Order as this Hon'ble Authority deems fit in the facts and circumstances of this case, in the interest of justice and equity.



- 5. The Authority, Karnataka shall take decision on the recommendations of the SEAC, Karnataka.
- The Chairman and Members of the SEAC. Karnataka shall hold office for a term of three years from the date of publication of this notification in the Official Gazette.
- 7. The SEAC, Karnataka shall exercise such powers and follow such procedures as are enumerated in the said Gazette notification.
- 8. The SEAC, Karnataka shall function on the principle of collective responsibility and the Chairman shall endeavor to reach a consensus in each case, and if consensus cannot be reached, the opinion of the majority shall prevail.
- 9. The State Government of Karnataka shall notify an agency to act as secretariat for the Authority, Karnataka and shall provide all financial and logistic support including accommodation, transportation and such other facilities in respect of all its statutory functions.
- 10. Sitting fee, travelling allowance and dearness allowance to the Chairman and Members of the Authority, Karnataka shall be paid in accordance with the rules of the State Government of Karnataka.
